

## Formula Bambino Round 6 - Saturday 9th June 2012

Proceedings started at 9am with a quick welcome to all drivers for round 6 of the 2012 season of formula bambino championship. This round we had 6 drivers which meant a grand total of 4 heats of 3 drivers per heat we also welcomed Jake Dickinson to the Formula Bambino championship for his first ever round.

Heat 1 – Ethan, Mackenzie and Jonathan took to the track for the first session of the day, it was Jonathan who set the early pace with a 30.531, Ethan was 0.855 seconds off the early pace, after 8 laps Jonathan managed to shave off a few tenths to take him into the 29 second lap times, with every lap Ethan and Mackenzie were chasing him down. For the next few laps Jonathan could not better his time whereas Ethan and Mackenzie continued to improve on their times. With four minutes to go Ethan managed to close the gap to 0.625s with Mackenzie being just a further 0.5 seconds behind Ethan. As the clock ran out Ethan made a last attempt to set the quickest time but only managed a 30.330s so it was Jonathan who managed to hold onto the heat win with a 29.810s

Heat 2 – Jacob, Alex and new comer Jack were next out on track for their first session of the day, Jacob set the early pace with a 31.535s Alex was only 0.146s behind in second place. Jake took a while to find his grove but soon settled in. As the laps clocked up both Jacob and Alex continued to improve maintaining the gap between them at a consistent 0.106s, on lap 20 Jacob managed to pull a 31.030 second lap times out of the bag. Alex continued to push but just couldn't seem to find the extra legs needed to close the gap. With a minute to go Jacob managed to improve his time once again to a 31.019s keeping Alex 0.316 seconds behind and holding on for the quickest time of the heat.

Heat 3 – Ethan, Mackenzie and Jonathan took to the track for their second session of the day. All drivers desperate to improve on the times set in the first session and hopefully take the top step of the podium. It was Ethan who set the early pace this time out with a 30.282, a time which was bettered the following lap. Mackenzie was 1.164s behind with a 31.171 with Jonathan in third with a 31.481s. After 5 laps Ethan managed to put in a 29.588s a time that surely was going to be hard to beat. With 12 laps down Ethan was still the quickest with Mackenzie in second on 30.348s and Jonathan in third with a 30.890s. as the clock counted down it was Ethan who held onto the lead with 29.588, Mackenzie took second with a 30.090 with Jonathan in third with a 30.255s.

Heat 4 – the last heat of the day saw Jacob, Alex and Jack hit the track to see if they could improve on their first session times. It was once again Jacob who set the early pace with a 30.805s, this time Alex took a bit longer to find his grove being 1.391s off the pace. Jake managed to improve on his last session by setting a 34.913s after just 7 laps. On lap 8 Jacob improved his time and then again on lap 10, Alex still struggled to close the gap holding at a steady 1.373s behind Jacob. On lap 13 Alex improved his time slightly setting a 31.810 and then on the following lap he put in a 31.697 closing the gap to Jacob. On lap 24 Alex set a 31.310s but this still wasn't quick enough to knock Jacob off of the top slot, as the clock counted counted down it was Jacob who held onto the win with a 30.728s lap time
