



Last month's race winner Adam Davis looked to struggle for pace in qualifying, only just making it into the final shootout. Adam ended up qualifying in 4th position with Adam Bach taking Pole with a lap-time of 33.534 marginally quicker than Colin Samuel (33.580) and Daniel Lane (33.585).

Adam Bach made a good start to the race and lead from this point onwards. He looked to be relatively unchallenged during the race as Colin and Daniel got into a bit of a battle. An uncharacteristic mistake from Daniel at the hairpin on lap 15 meant he dropped down the pack to 8th position; this gave Colin a bit of breathing space but soon came under pressure from Adam Davis who managed to claim 2nd position on lap 52 of the 60 lap race. Daniel Lane, now up to 7th position, managed to get some clear track and put in some very fast lap-times. He recorded a personal best of 33.089 seconds, just under one tenth away from current lap record. Adam Bach took the race win by just over 12 seconds ahead of Adam Davis and Colin Samuel.
