Inkart Championship 2014



Heat 1

Andres got off to a good start from pole position pulling away right from the start. Logan also made a good start jumping past Eric to take 3rd place. A newcomer to Inkart was Jacob Mcdonald. He made a good start and knowing he was a

little off the pace stayed out of the way of the leaders and got his head down trying to improve over the course of the event. Back at the front Nathan Smith puts in the fastest lap of the race to catch Andres but he is

unable to overtake and finishes 0.224 seconds behind Andres and 4.6 seconds ahead of Logan.

Heat 2

A dramatic start to Heat 2 as Nathan crawls away from pole position with the whole field passing him before the bridge. An obvious kart failure saw him finish in last place although he was awarded points for 1st place

as it was out of his control. Alex Bomberg took full advantage of this and made his way into the lead of the race. Thomas Oxley got himself up into p2 in the opening laps and went on to chase down Alex but was unable to take the lead.

Andres had an uncharacteristic race only managing 4th place. Alex Bomberg took the race win ahead of Thomas and Michael Burrows.

Heat 3

The big mover off the start of heat 3 was Jordan Cain jumping up to 2nd by the end of lap 1 then overtaking Michael on lap 2 for the race lead. Eric Su also had a good race making his way back up into 2nd place after a slow

start dropping back to 4th, he pulled off a fantastic overtake on Michael over the bridge for 2nd place. Jordan then pulled away setting fastest lap of the race to take the win by nearly 9 seconds ahead of Eric Su with Michael Burrows

just holding on for 3rd position.

Heat 4

Jordan Cain was on pole position, looking to take another heat win to secure pole position for the final. Jordan got a good start but not as good as Andres who moved straight up into p3 then went on to pass Logan

and Jordan for the race lead. He then pulled a near 5 seconds lead to take the race win. Jordan in 2nd pulled around 2 second lead over Logan who was under immense pressure from Nathan and Alex

Whipday, The 3 drivers crossed the line within 0.8 of each other.

Heat 5

Alex Whipday on pole position for heat 5, He made a good start and held his position, Jordan moved up from 3rd into 2nd making a quick overtake on Thomas. He then went on to pass Alex for the race lead on lap 3.

Alex managed to hold on and stay in 2nd place until the chequered flag with a comfortable gap of 4 seconds over Thomas Oxley. Michael Burrows and Logan Parker had a very good battle right until the final

moments of the race when Michael crossed the line under 3 tenths ahead of Logan to take 4th place.

Heat 6

Newcomer Jacob on pole position, very sensible and allows the pack to pass him on the first lap, Putting Logan into the race lead ahead of Michael and Thomas. A pretty straightforward race saw only one position

change as Eric Su managed to make an overtake on Nathan Smith to take 4th place. Logan Parker managed to pull away to take the race win by 3 seconds. A very close battle behind saw Michael, Thomas and Eric

crossing the line within 0.3 of each other.

Heat 7

Thomas Oxley on pole position for heat 7. Jordan again having a storming race moving from p6 up into p4 on lap one then into p2 on lap 2. Thomas by this point was too far ahead for Jordan to do anything. Alex Whipday was

given a black flag for ABC on Alex Bomberg through the tunnel. A strong race for Andres as he sat in 3rd position and managed to stay out of trouble to hold his position until the end. Thomas Oxley took the race

win by 3 seconds over Jordan with Andres a further 3 seconds behind.

The Finals

Michael Burrows started the B-Final in first and looked comfortable after making a good start. Alex Bomberg made a poor start and lost out to Eric Su and Alex Whipday dropping to 4th. Michael looking in control of the race upfront. Looking comfortable in the kart and holding a 1.5 seconds gap back to Eric to secure his place in the A-Final. Eric 2nd and Alex Whipday taking 3rd place.

best but looked to settle for 2nd place. A straightforward final saw only 1 person dropping down the order, Nathan Smith appeared to make a mistake and dropped behind Logan Parker and Michael Burrows down to last place. Jordan Cain put in a fastest Lap of 30.679 to take the race win by 7.676 seconds over Andres who was a further 12 seconds ahead of Thomas Oxley.

The A-Final saw Jordan Cain on pole position. He made a good start and immediately started to pull away from Andres who was doing his
